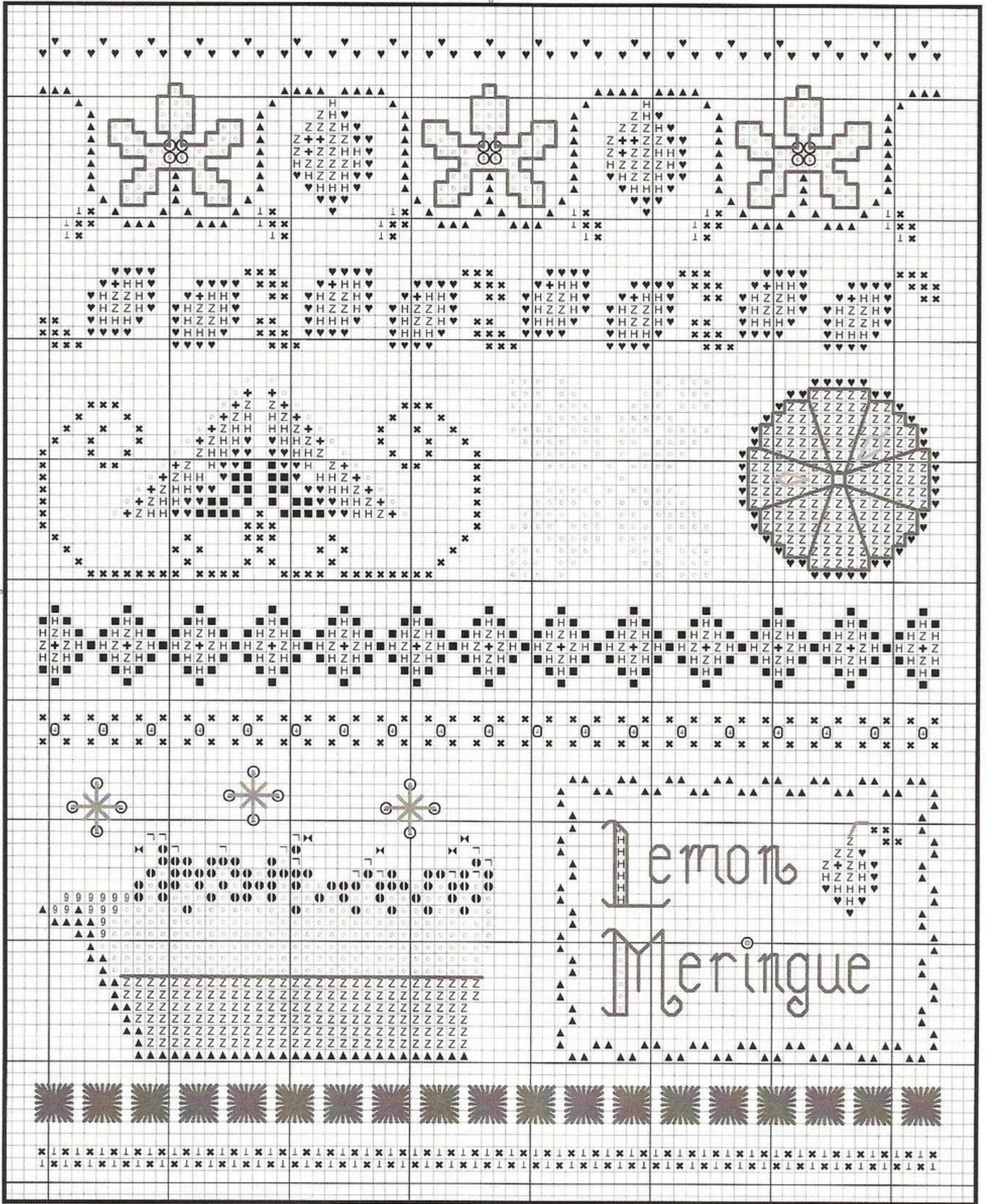




Lemon Meringue Sampler

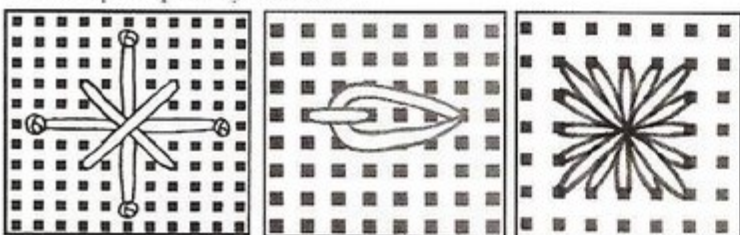

Instructions:

All cross stitching done with two strands.
 Backstitching around blossoms, use one strand of 3820. For French knots in blossoms, use one strand of 436 wrapped twice. Backstitching around segments of lemon, use two strands of white. Lazy daisy stitches, use two strands of 436. "Lemon" use two strands of 3820. "Meringue" use two strands of 3774. Dot the "i" with a French knot, wrapped twice. Stem for small lemon, use one strand of 434. Star stitches use one strand of 434. For French knots, wrap twice. Backstitching on pie slice, use one strand of 726. Square eyelets, use one strand of white.
