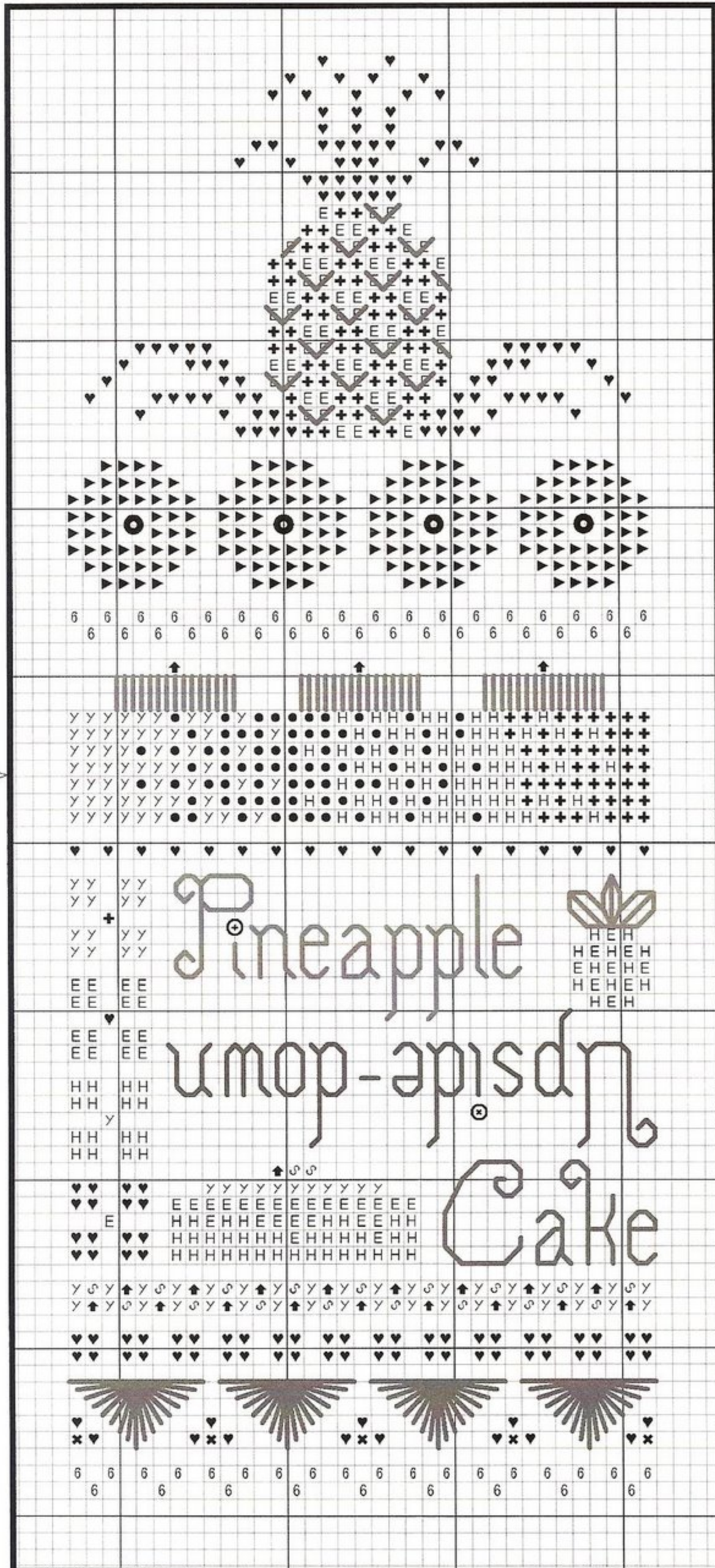




Pineapple Upside-Down Cake

Fabric: Charles Craft Monaco Ivory 28 ct. (2 over 2)

Stitch count 35W x 86H

Also 300 and 307 -for backstitching.
Beads: 4 cherry colored pebble beads. (Shown are "Mainstays Crafts" Glass E beads in transparent red.) Symbol: ●

Instructions:

For all cross stitching, use two strands.
Backstitching:
 "V's" in pineapple— one strand 300.
 For the three pineapple slices on cake, use satin stitch with two strands 307.
 "Pineapple"—use two strands of 782.
 Dot the "i" with a French knot of same color.
 "Upside-down"—use two strands of 906. Dot the "i" with French knot of same color.
 Leaves on small pineapple—use one strand of 986.
 "Cake" —use two strands of 301.
 For bottom triangle satin stitches, use one strand of 3822.
 After stitching, iron flat. Secure pebble beads in center of each pineapple slice.

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
