NAVY BLUE: Go for 20 count Zweigart evenweave, ref 3256/547



NATURAL: 19 count Zweigart Ariosa, ref 3711/59, has a lovely soft mottled finish



RUBY RED: Pack a red punch with 19 count Zweigart Ariosa, ref 3711/9317

Don't be put off if you don't have a sewing machine. You can stitch up a simple cushion like this by hand in just one evening.
