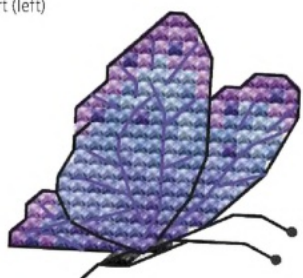
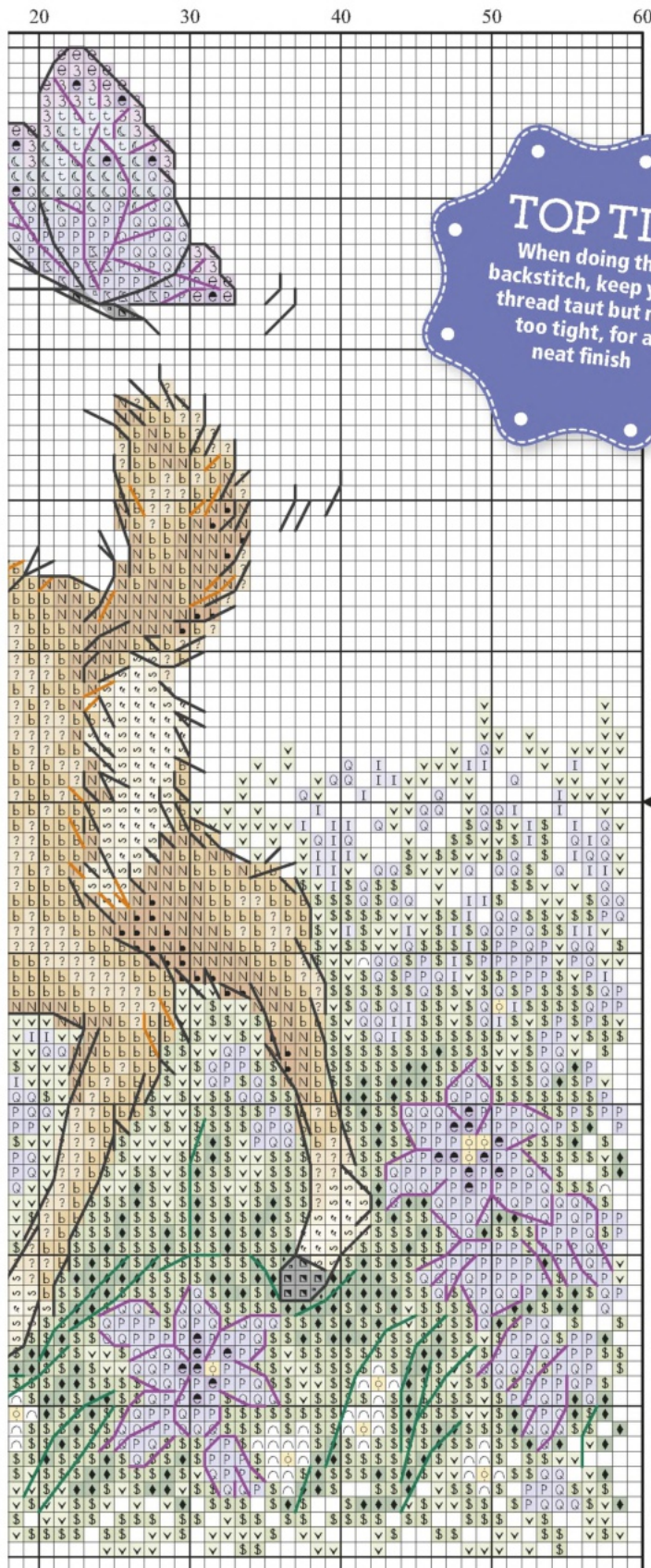

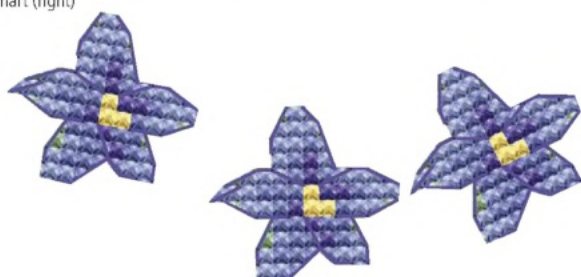

DESIGN AREA 14 HPI (28-count evenweave) – 18x21.5cm (7¼x8½in)

SKEINS NEEDED 2x368 (green)

This design was stitched using DMC stranded cotton

- ✦ Zweigart* 14-count white aida measuring 33x36cm (13x14¼in)
- ✦ Stranded cotton as listed in the key
- ✦ Size 24 tapestry needle
- ✦ Frame of your choice with a minimum aperture of 20x23cm (7¾x9in)
