HOW TO...stitch over two threads

Designs are stitched over two threads on a high-count evenweave like Cashel linen. You should count both along and up two holes each time you take a stitch. A cross stitch will then cover a nine-hole square (instead of one with four holes as on aida). You will find this makes designs containing lots of fractional stitches much easier.
