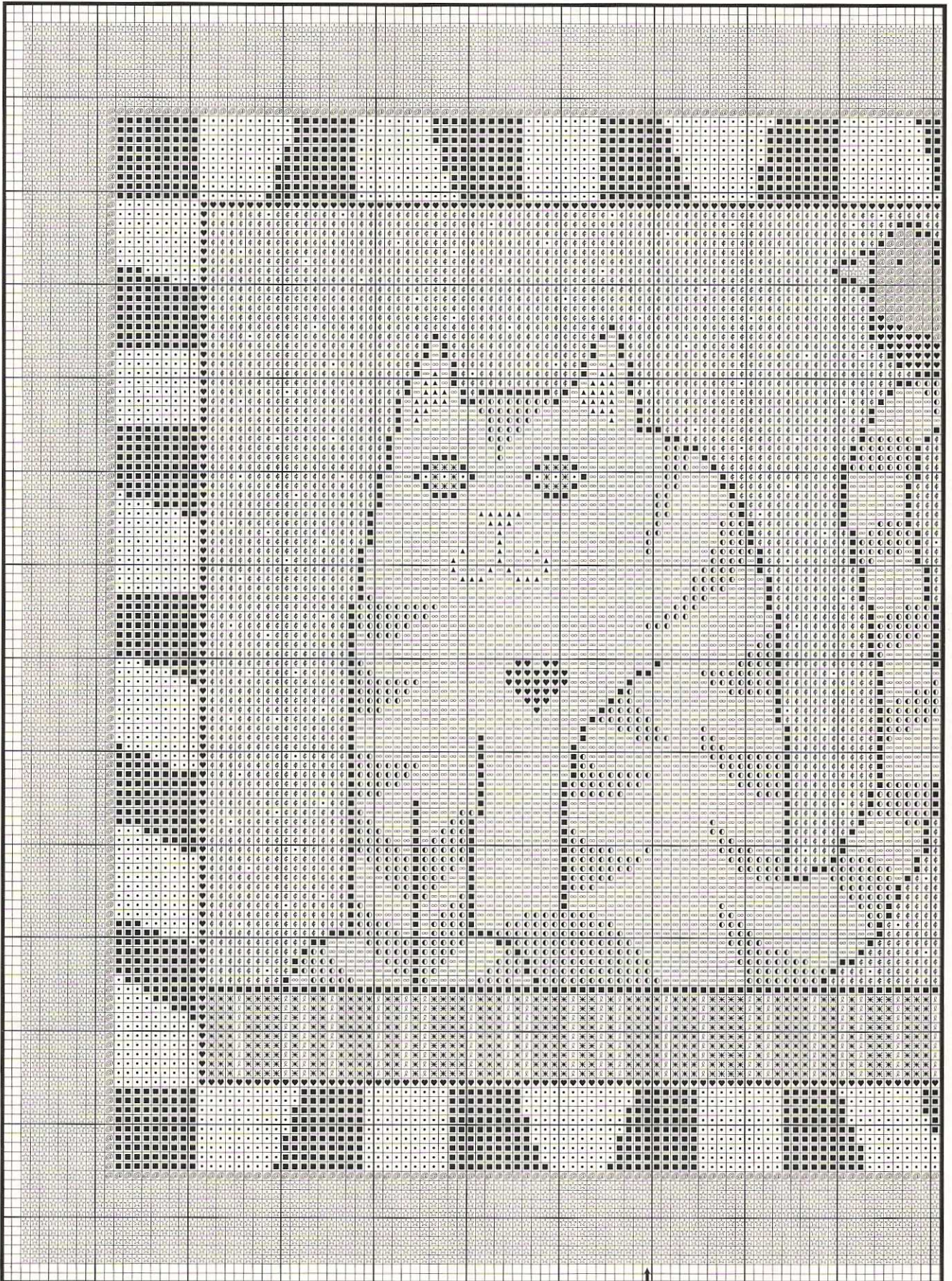
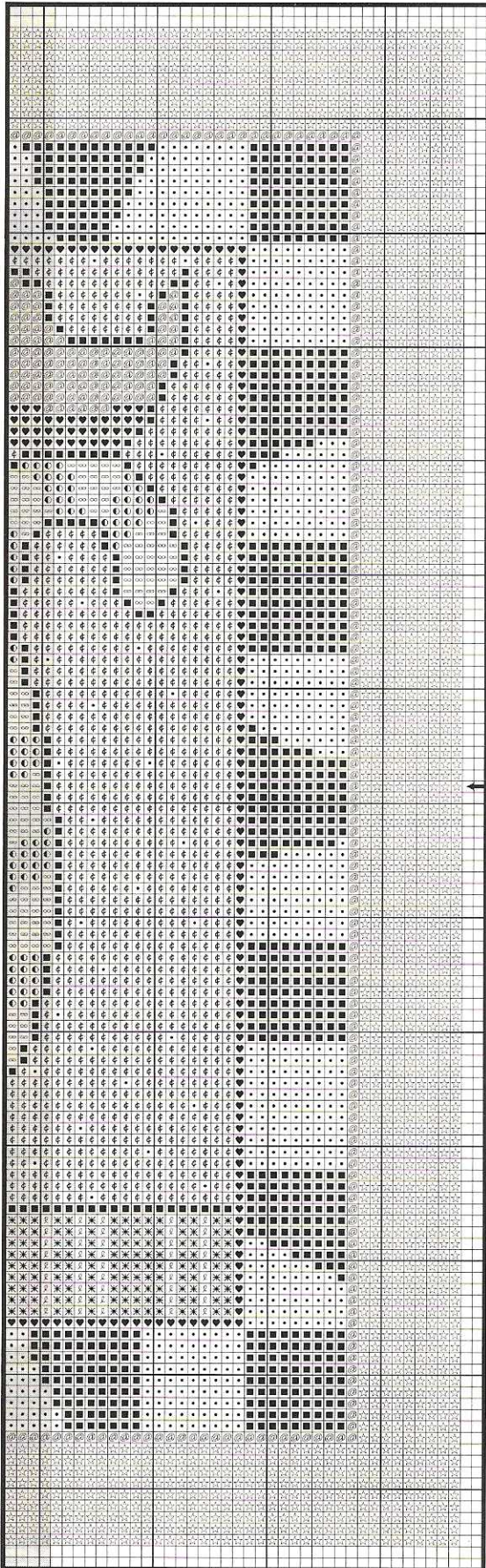

- 16" x 16" piece 14-count white Aida from Charles Craft*
 - One skein each DMC® or Anchor® six-strand embroidery floss (Model uses DMC® floss.)**
 - Size 24 tapestry needle

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Materials:

- 1 yd. coordinating decorator fabric (Model uses blue piqué fabric.)
- ⅓ yd. coordinating strip fabric
- 2 yds. coordinating feather trim
- 2 yds. cotton cording
- Ruler
- Clover Hera Marker™ (temporary creasing tool, available at fabric stores)
- Coordinating sewing thread
- Polyester fiberfill
- Hand-sewing needle
- Sewing machine with zipper foot (optional)

Press stitched piece from wrong side, straightening as much as possible. Trim stitched piece to approximately ½" from stitching on all sides.

From decorator fabric, cut four 4" x 16" rectangles. Align one rectangle with
