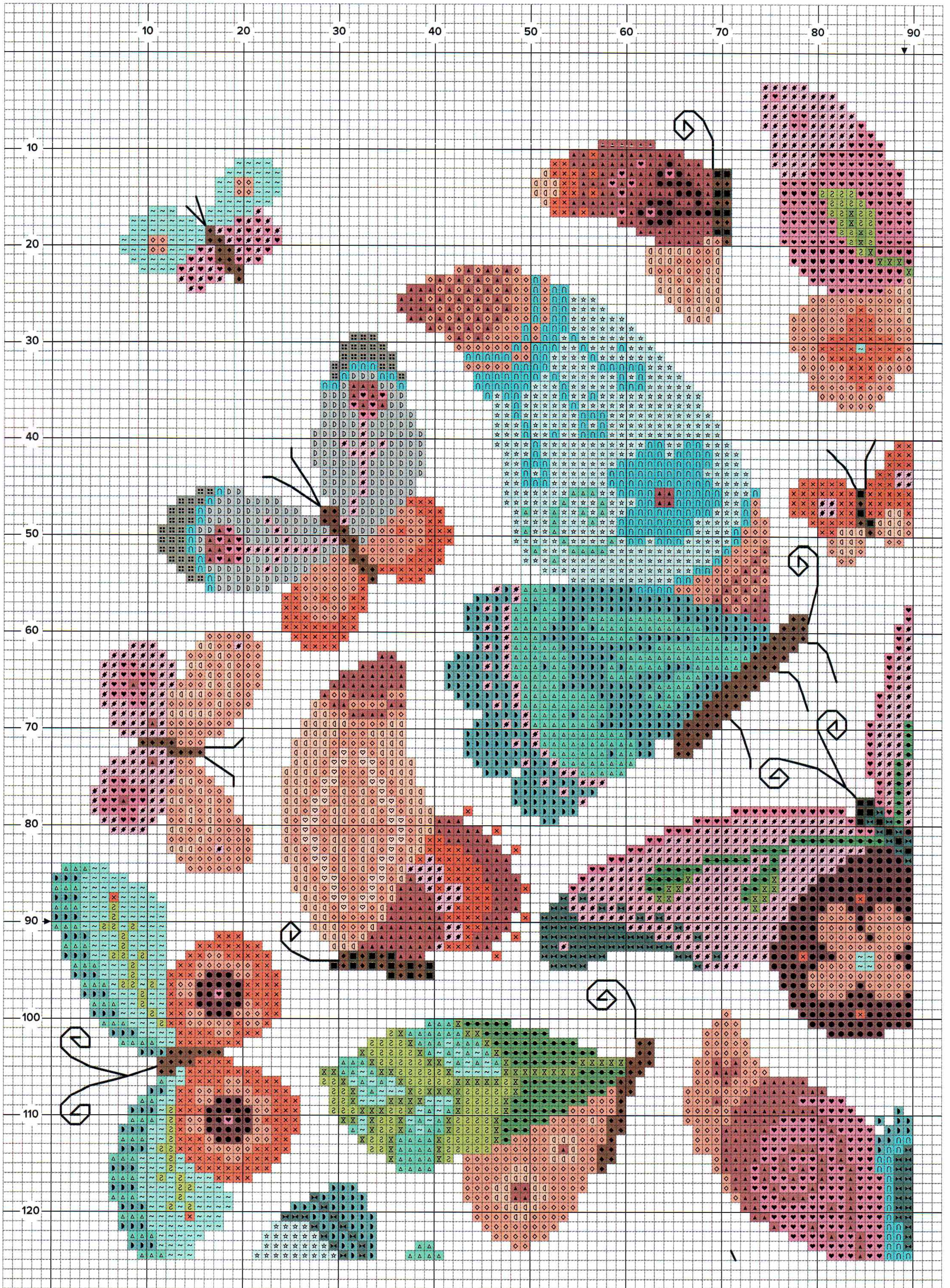
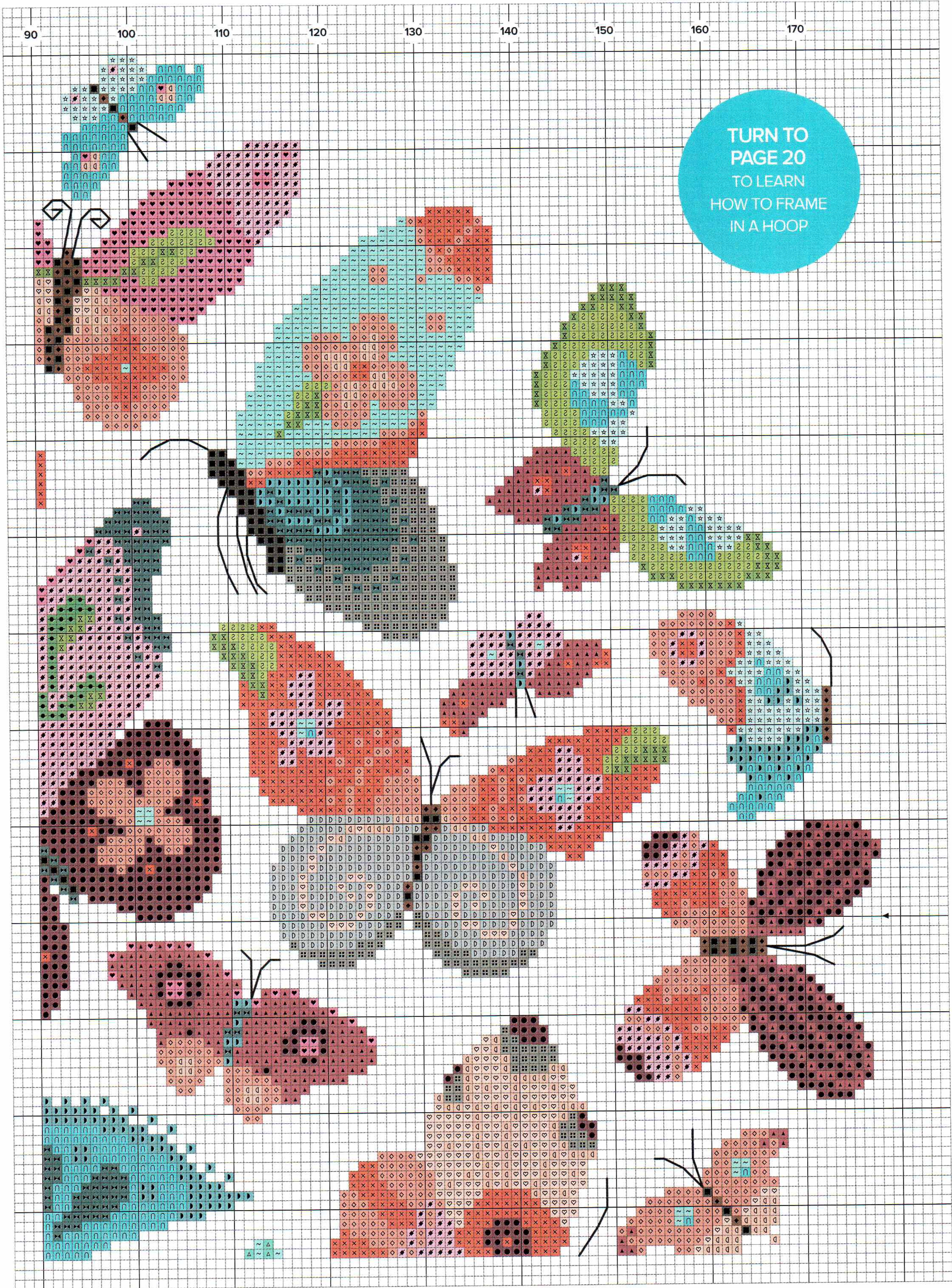

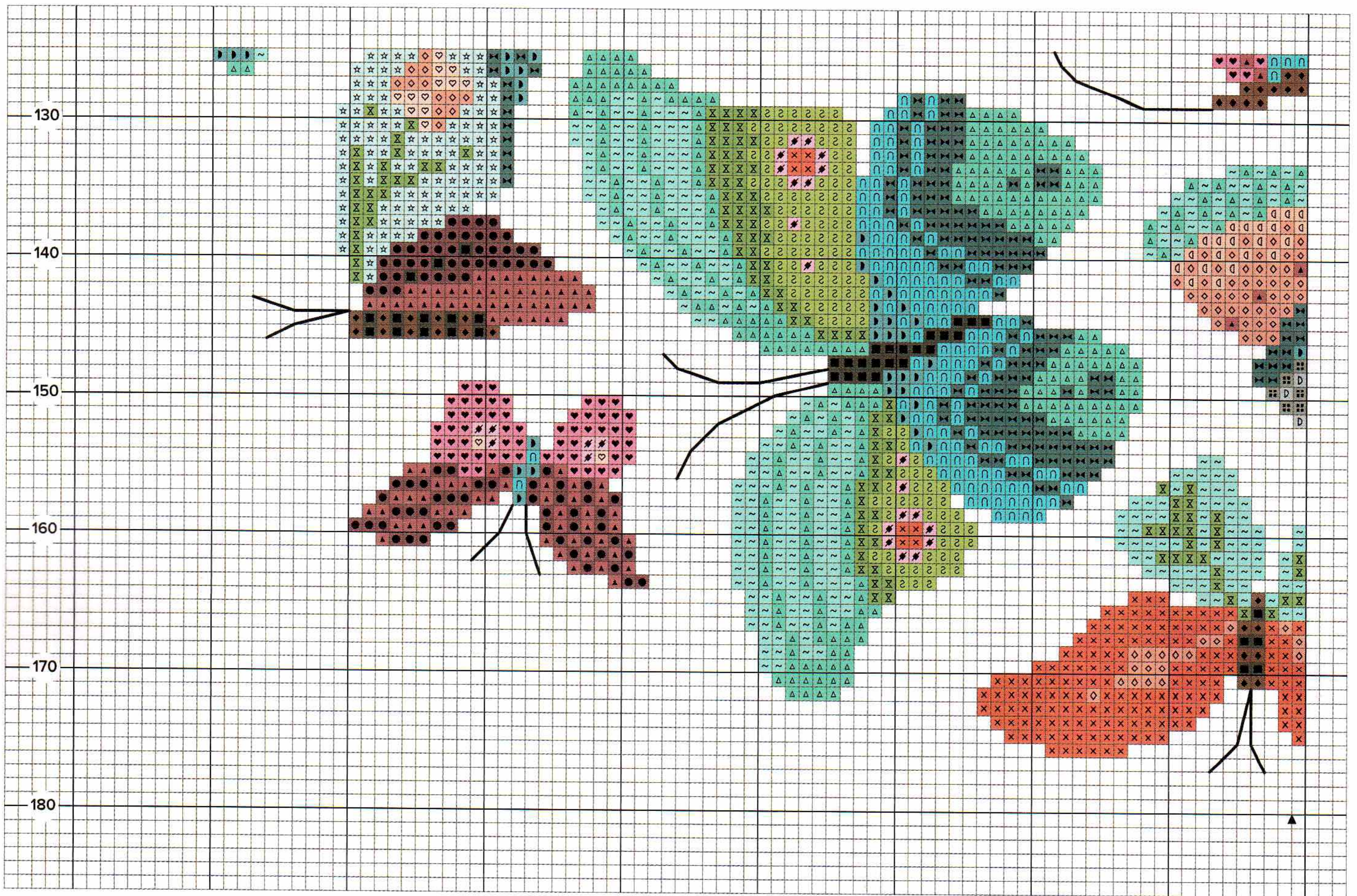

Designed by: Emma Congdon **Stitch count: 180 high x 178 wide**

**Design size: 32x33cm (12½x13in) Stitch time: 70 hours**

This design was stitched on 27 count evenweave over two threads of fabric.

*Go for a completely different effect by stitching this design on a dark evenweave fabric instead*

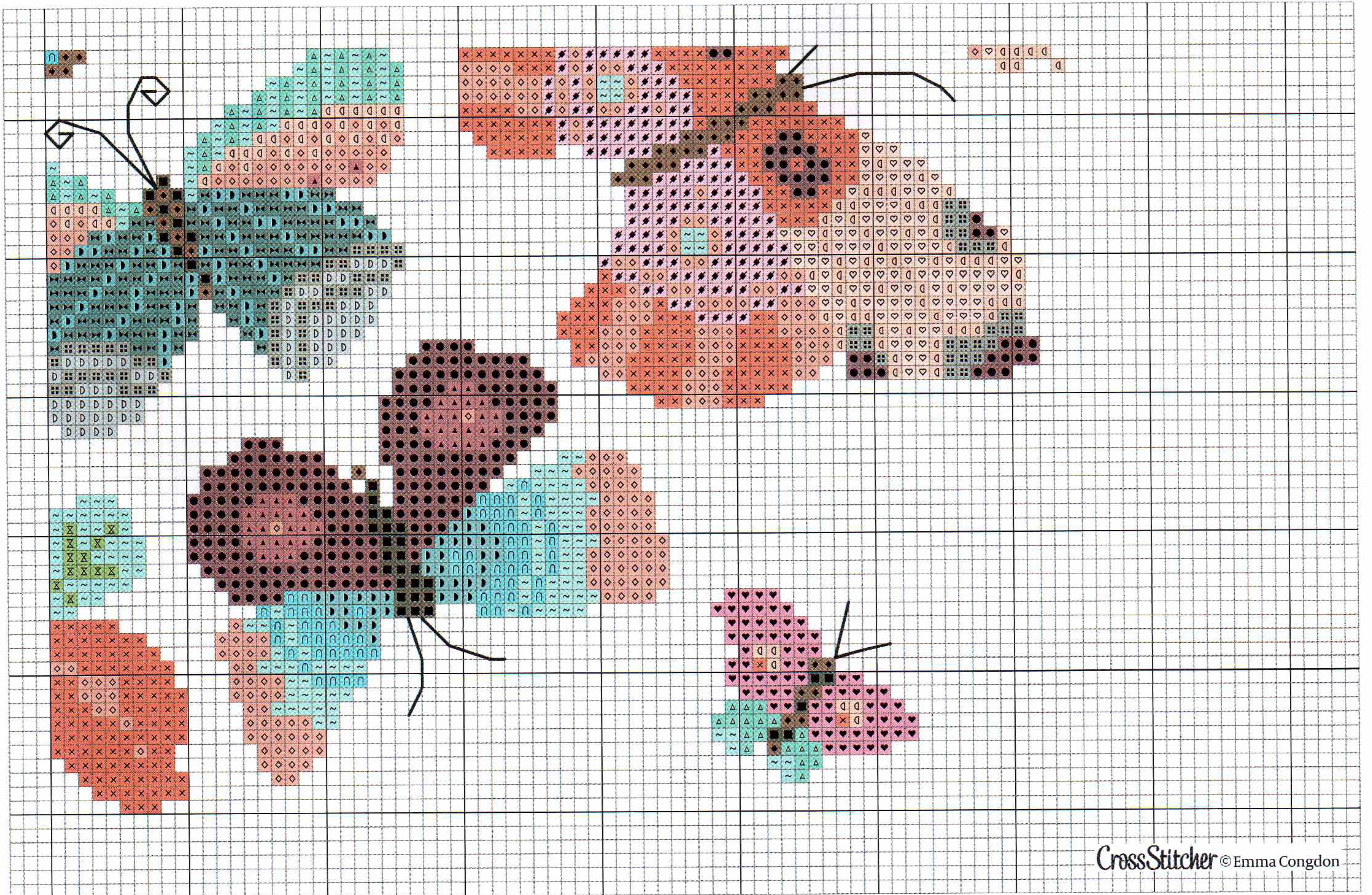
## Materials

- Zweigart Antique White, 27 count Linda, ref: 1235/101; 51x51cm (20x20in)
- Stranded cotton as listed in the key
- Size 26 tapestry needle
- Wooden quilting hoop, 33cm (13in) diameter

## Make a... butterfly display

### Step 1

**FINISH** stitching the main design and then stitch more mini butterfly hoops to create a complete display for your wall, if you wish.

### Step 2

**STITCH** the three smaller butterflies outside of the main design on the chart onto a small piece of yellow evenweave, then frame in a hoop.

### Step 3

**SELECT** butterflies from the main design that can be stitched onto perforated paper. Once the stitching on paper is complete, cut out, leaving one square of blank paper around the stitching. Wrap string around the butterfly's body for the antennae, and attach to fabric mounted in a hoop.
