For perfect results, we suggest you stitch the sampler in DMC threads on 28 count evenweave over two threads

Sampler stitch count 99 high x 71 wide
Design area 18x13cm (7x5in)

The black mount board and gold gilt frame really make the details in this design stand out

Nice and even

Evenweave fabric is made up of neatly woven threads so make sure all of your stitches are worked over two vertical and two horizontal threads.



Timesaver

If you're not a fan of evenweave try working this design on to 14 count aida instead. It's a lot quicker to stitch on to as well!
