FLOSS USAGE

- Use 2 plies for all cross stitches.
- Use 1 ply for all backstitches.
- Sometimes a backstitch will go over a cross stitch. We have made two small symbols on either side of the backstitch so that you might see the symbol easier. Complete your cross stitch first, then stitch the backstitch.

KEY FOR BACKSTITCHES - 1 ply

- All backstitches - 3371 - Black Brown

FINISHING - FABRIC VARIES SO CAREFULLY CHECK THE CARDBOARD PIECE WITH YOUR STITCHED PIECE TO ADJUST LARGER OR SMALLER. THIS MAY MEAN CUTTING A DIFFERENT SIZE CARDBOARD INSERT.

- Trim fabric 14 squares from design.
- Folds sides and top back, leaving four fabric squares beyond the design. Finger press. Fold the point making sure you leave the same amount of white showing as the sides.
- Cut a piece of cardboard 4" x 9 1/2". Measure down 7 1/2" on one of the long sides. Make a dot. Repeat on the other side. Now make a dot 2" in on the bottom short side. Draw a line from each of the side dots to this dot to make a point. Trim off these excess.
- Cut a piece of batting the same size as the cardboard. Put a few drops of tacky glue on the cardboard to hold the batting in place
- Place design on batting and cardboard folding the excess to the back. Glue excess to cardboard back with tacky glue. Trim excess as necessary at corners and point.
- Cut a piece of felt 1" larger than your piece. Glue stitched piece to felt.
- Using pinking shears, trim felt slightly larger than finished piece.
- Cut a piece of 3/8" ribbon 36" long. Cut in half and sew to top back corners. Tie in a bow to hang over door or hook.
