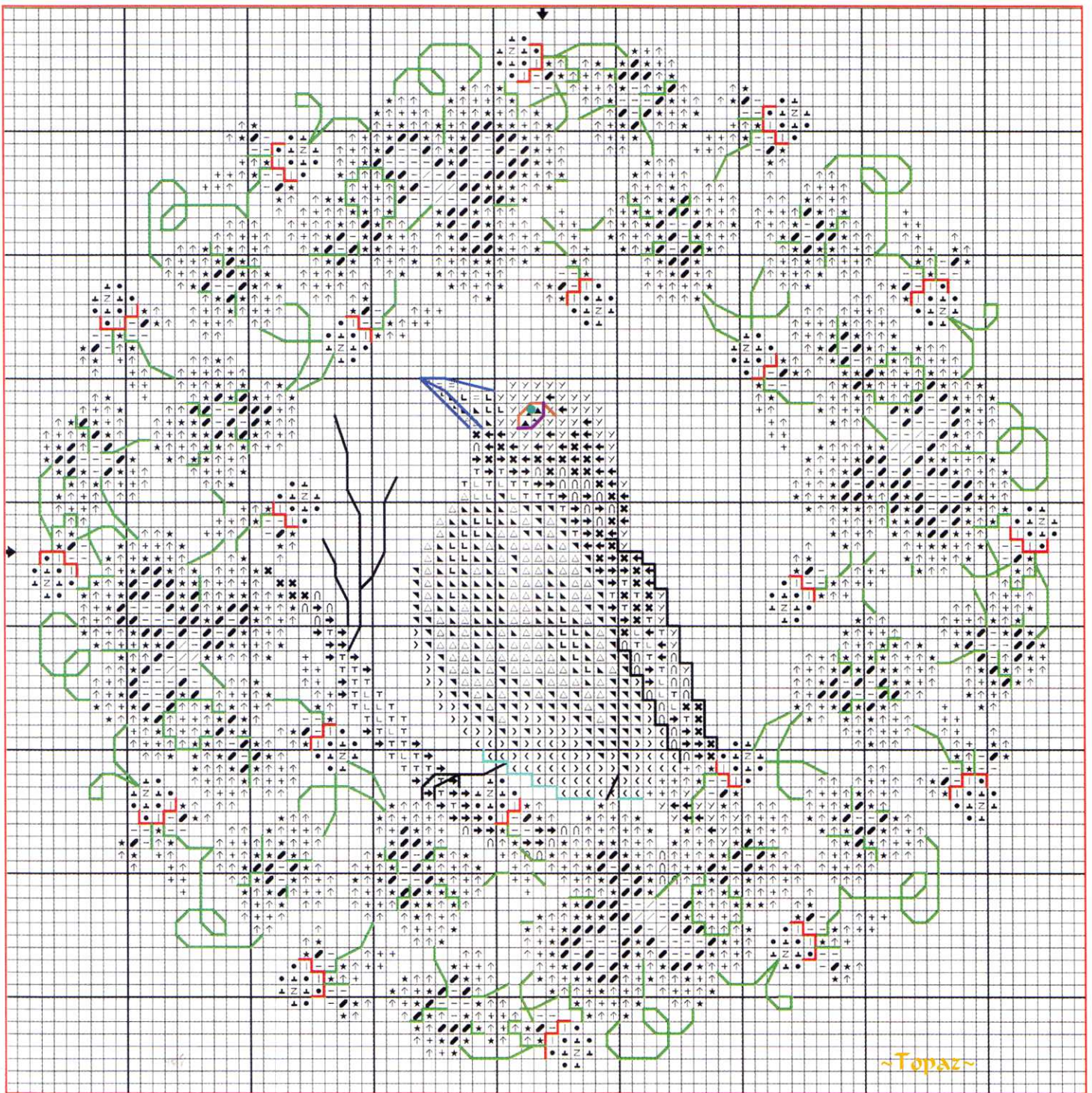


Mystery Series

Have you ever tried to guess "who-done-it" as you were reading a book? Or worked on a mystery quilt, one square at a time? Now you can solve a mystery by stitching one section at a time.

This is the first part of four-part series. You won't see a picture of the completed project until the fourth part is published in October. I hope you enjoy using your needle and floss to solve this mystery. **NOTE:** If you are going to stitch all four designs on one piece of fabric, you will need a piece of fabric 12" wide by 31 1/2" long.)

Materials:

12" x 12" White 14-count Aida
6-strand Embroidery Floss - DMC®

Cross-stitch: 2 strands

Backstitch: 1 strand

French Knot: 2 strands (wrapped twice)

Stitch Count: 84 w x 84 h

Approximate Finished Size: 6" w x 6" h

Instructions: Stitch design centered on fabric if you are stitching each design on a separate piece of fabric.

If you are stitching all four designs on one piece of fabric, measure 9 1/2" down from short edge of fabric and

stitch a running stitch across fabric.

Measure 6 1/2" down from this running stitch and stitch another running stitch across fabric. Measure 6 1/2" again from running stitch and stitch another running stitch across fabric. You have now divided the fabric in four segments.

Begin stitching Part 1 in the second divided section making sure to center design horizontally.
