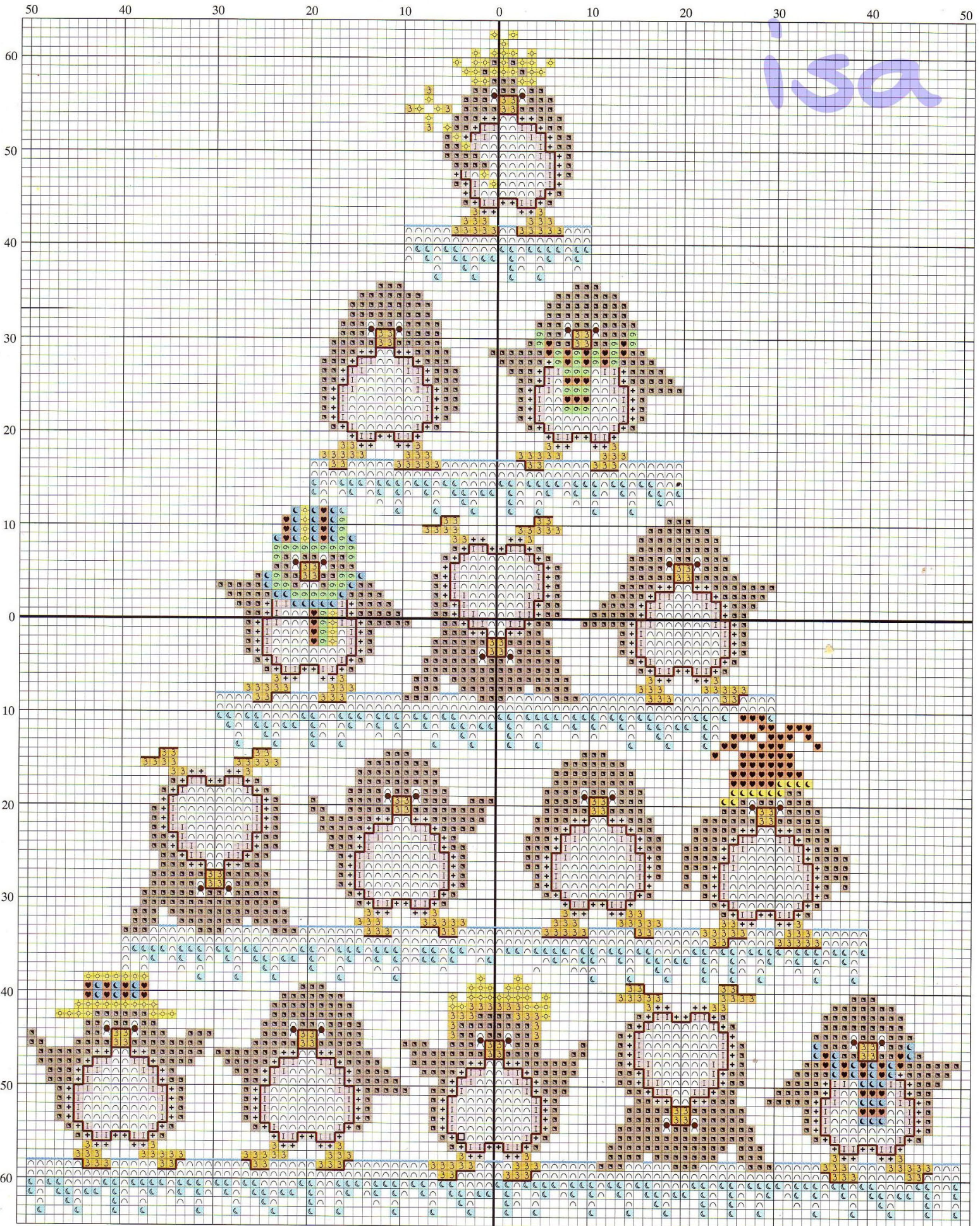


CROSS STITCH CHARTS PENGUIN PYRAMID



Time-saving IDEA

If you like this design but don't have time to stitch it all, pick out two or three of the penguins and stitch them on separate pieces of sky blue Jobelan. Mount them individually in their own frames and hang them together to create a group of matching pictures.

► SHOPPING LIST PENGUIN PYRAMID

Fabric	28-count light blue Jobelan (NJ429.21 – contact <i>Fabric Flair</i> on ☎ 0800 716 851 for stockists details), measuring 39.5x30.5cm (15½x12in)
Threads	stranded cotton as listed on the key
Needle size	size 26 tapestry
TOTAL COST	excluding frame £10

Knot a PROBLEM

The eyes of these cheeky penguins have been stitched using French knots. If you usually find this stitch a problem, turn to our helpful guide on page 88. You can substitute seed beads for French knots to add another dimension to your stitching if you like.

Stitching TIP

Always remember to wash your hands before stitching. This is especially important when stitching on light coloured fabric as it can soon become a grubby as you stitch.
