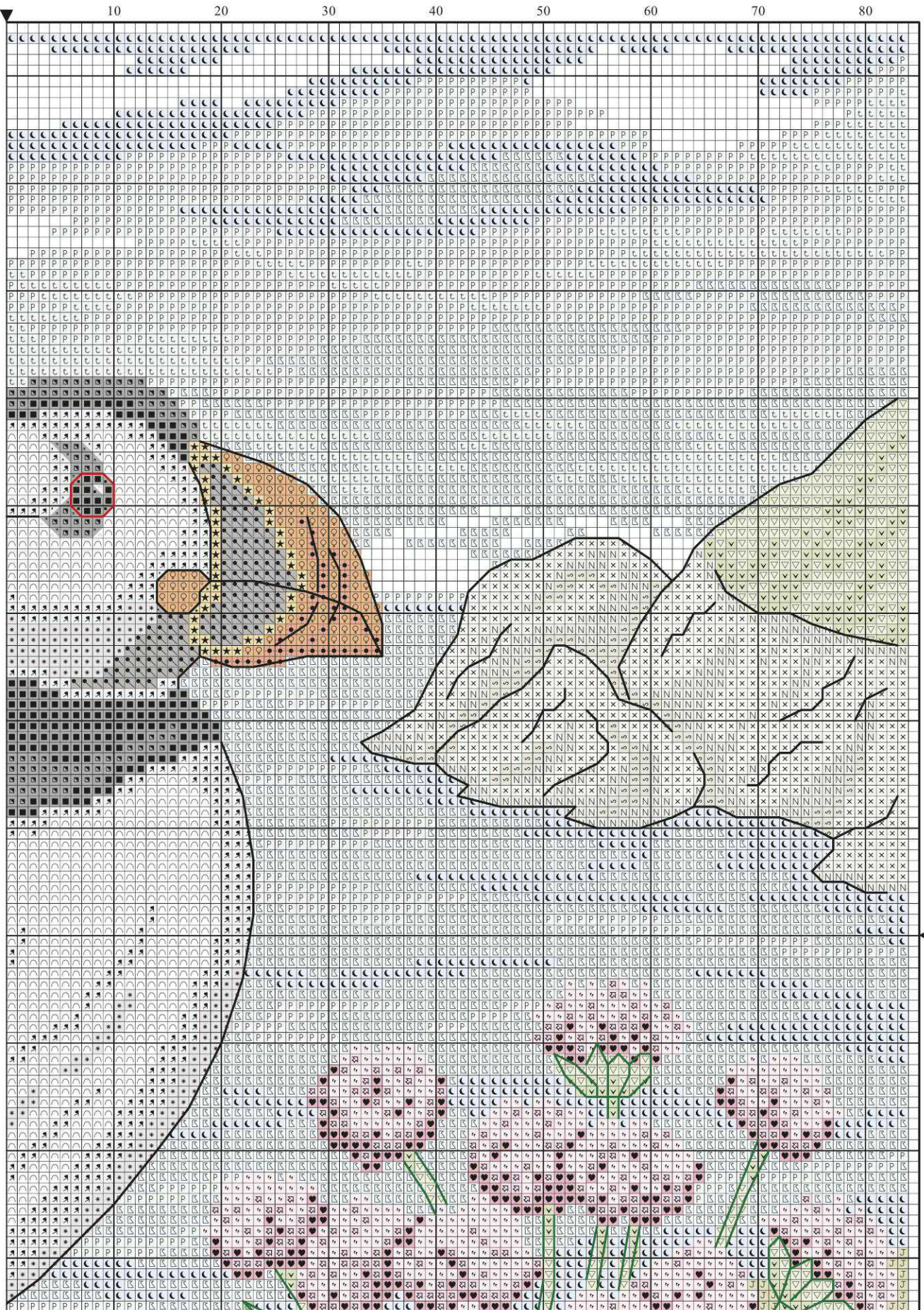
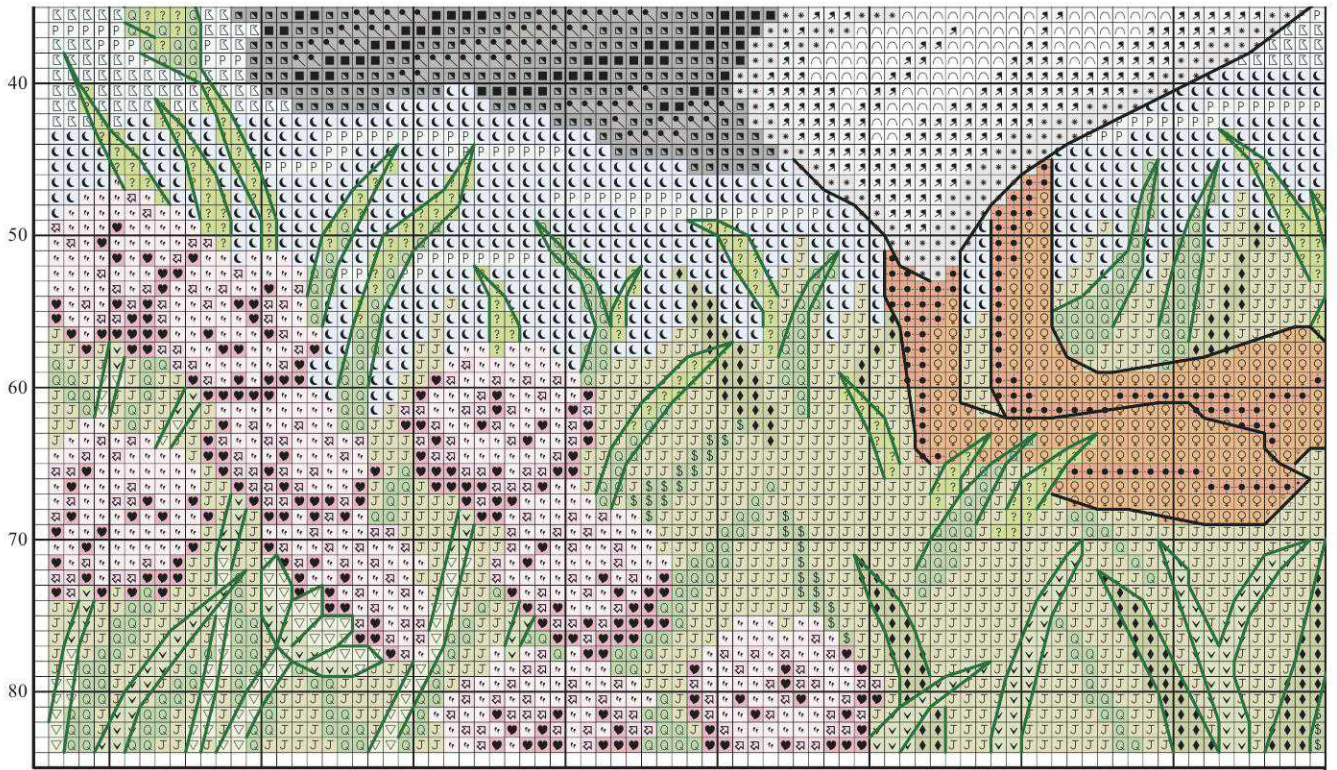


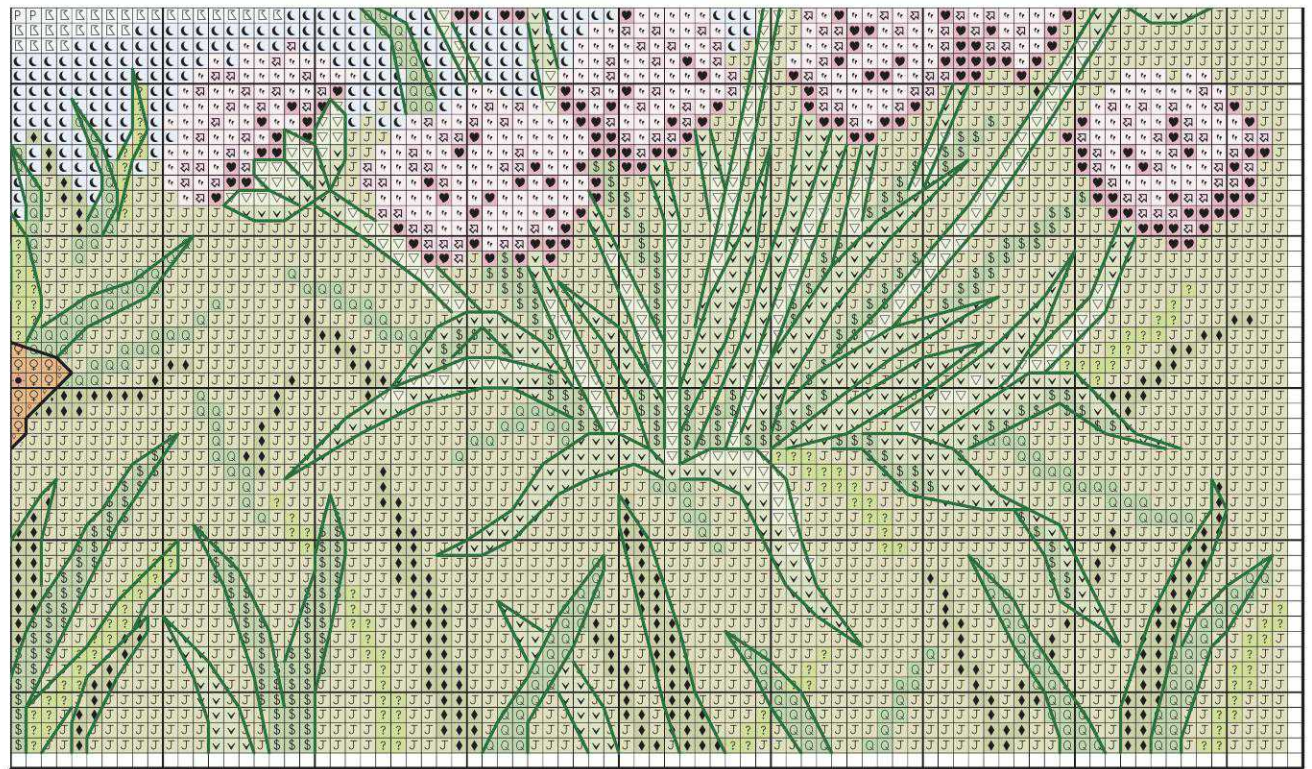
Seaside Puffin chart (top left)

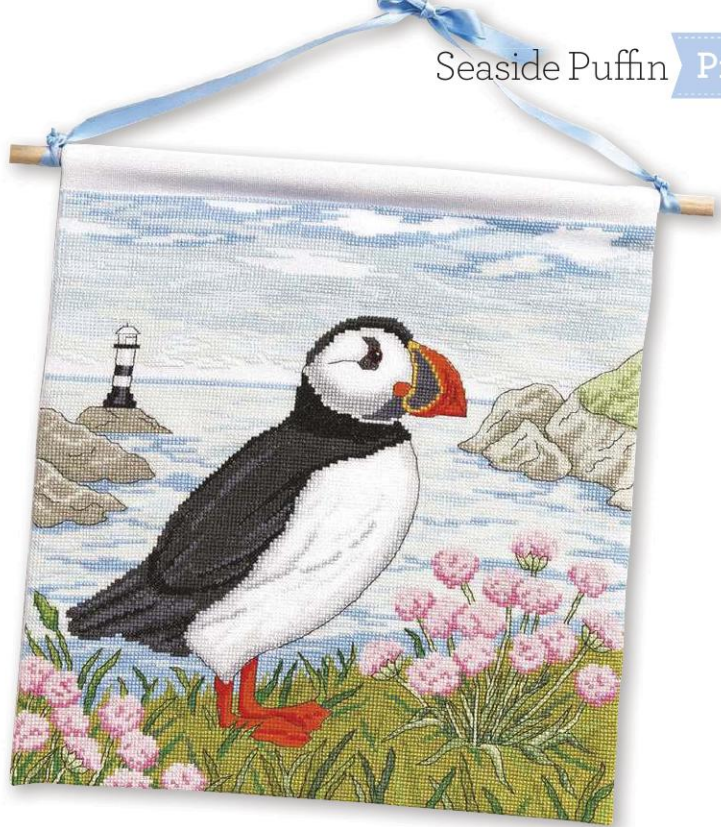

STITCH COUNT 168 high x 168 wide

DESIGN AREA 14 HPI (28-count evenweave) – 30.5x30.5cm (12x12in)

SKEINS NEEDED 2x471 (light moss green), 3x775 (china blue), 2x3325 (powder blue), 3x3756 (light china blue)

This design was stitched using DMC stranded cotton on 28-count evenweave over two threads of the fabric



How to...

make a hanging

1 Carefully trim your finished stitched piece using a pair of sharp fabric scissors, leaving a 2cm (¾in) seam allowance on the side edges and the bottom edge, and a 10cm (4in) seam allowance along the top edge.

2 Next, cut a piece of plain backing fabric to the same size as your stitched piece. Pin both pieces of fabric together, right sides facing. Machine- or hand-stitch with a 2cm (¾in) seam along the bottom edge and the two sides, close to the edges of your stitching, and leaving the top edge open.

3 Trim away excess fabric at the corners, as this will reduce bulk. Then turn through and gently press with an iron.

4 Turn a 2.5cm (1in) hem at the top of your fabric, press and carefully pin in place. Machine- or hand-stitch along this hem, creating a channel for the dowel to slot through.

5 Insert your dowel rod and then finish off by tying a ribbon of your choice, for hanging.



TOP TIP

Be sure to check the key carefully, as you'll need to use multiple skeins of some colours to stitch this project!

- ✦ Zweigart* 28-count white evenweave measuring 45x45cm (17¾x17¾in)
- ✦ Stranded cotton as listed in the key
- ✦ Size 26 tapestry needle
- ✦ Wooden dowel measuring 37cm (14½in), backing fabric and ribbon of your choice from local stores
