

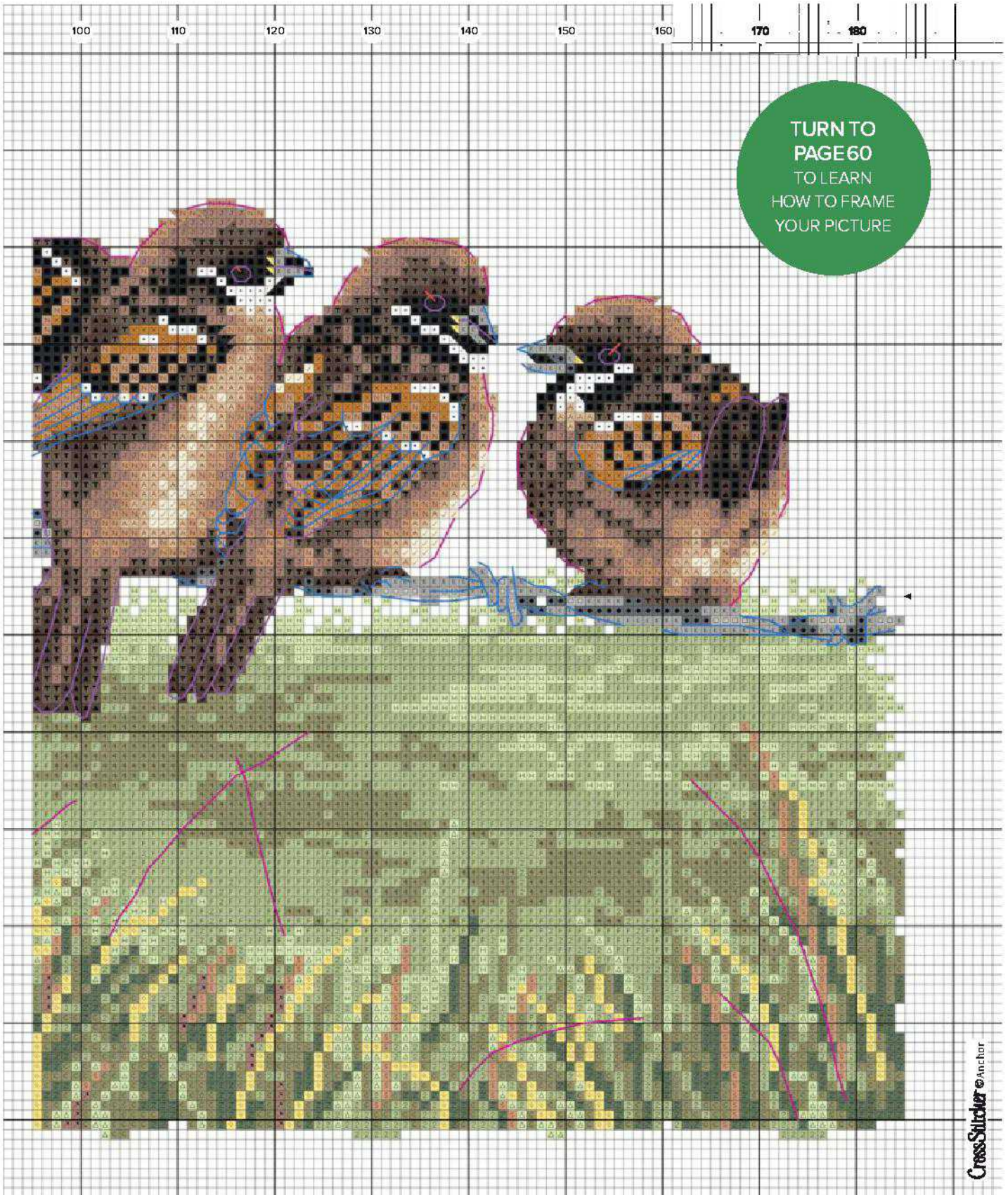

  - Anchor stranded cotton as listed in the key
  - Size 24 tapestry needle
  - Frame with a 30.5x41.5cm (12x16¼in) aperture
  - Mount board to fit frame
