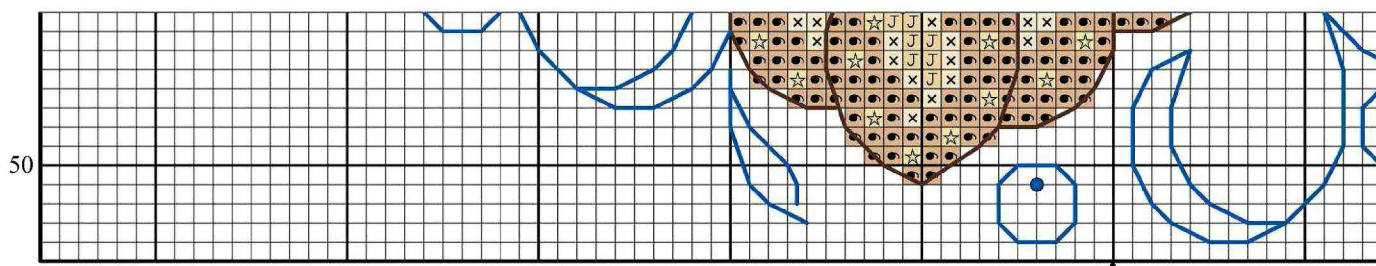


Sparkly Owl chart (top left)

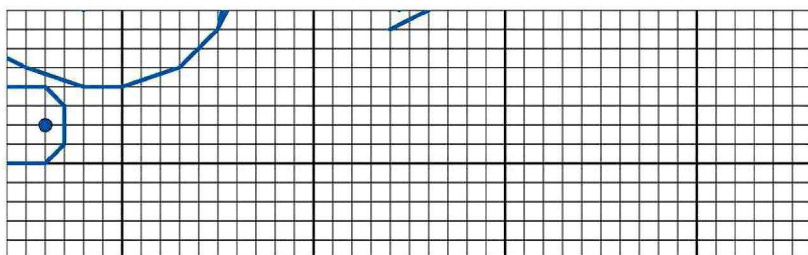








Sparkly Owl chart (bottom left)

## How to...

## work the eyelet stitches

The sequins are attached using eyelet stitches. To work an eyelet stitch, bring your needle up in the middle of the sequin and take it down at the edge. Work in an anti-clockwise direction at even intervals until you've completed the circle with eight stitches.

## Shopping list

- ✗ Zweigart\* 28-count cream (264) evenweave measuring 30x30cm (11¾x11¾in)
- ✗ Stranded cotton and metallic thread as listed in the key
- ✗ Mill Hill\* seed beads as listed in the key
- ✗ Josy Rose\* sequins as listed in the key
- ✗ Size 26 tapestry needle; beading needle
- ✗ 8in (EH8) wooden embroidery hoop from Siesta Frames\*
- ✗ Fabric for backing and ribbon of your choice from local stores
