


Sparkly Owl chart (top left)




STITCH COUNT 108 high x 110 wide

DESIGN AREA 14 HPI (28-count evenweave) – 19.5x20cm (7¾x7¾in)

This design was stitched using DMC stranded cotton, DMC Light Effects, Mill Hill seed beads and *Josy Rose sequins on 28-count evenweave over two threads of the fabric.

How to...

work the eyelet stitches

The sequins are attached using eyelet stitches. To work an eyelet stitch, bring your needle up in the middle of the sequin and take it down at the edge. Work in an anti-clockwise direction at even intervals until you've completed the circle with eight stitches.

- ✗ Zweigart* 28-count cream (264) evenweave measuring 30x30cm (11¾x11¾in)
- ✗ Stranded cotton and metallic thread as listed in the key
- ✗ Mill Hill* seed beads as listed in the key
- ✗ Josy Rose* sequins as listed in the key
- ✗ Size 26 tapestry needle; beading needle
- ✗ 8in (EH8) wooden embroidery hoop from Siesta Frames*
- ✗ Fabric for backing and ribbon of your choice from local stores
