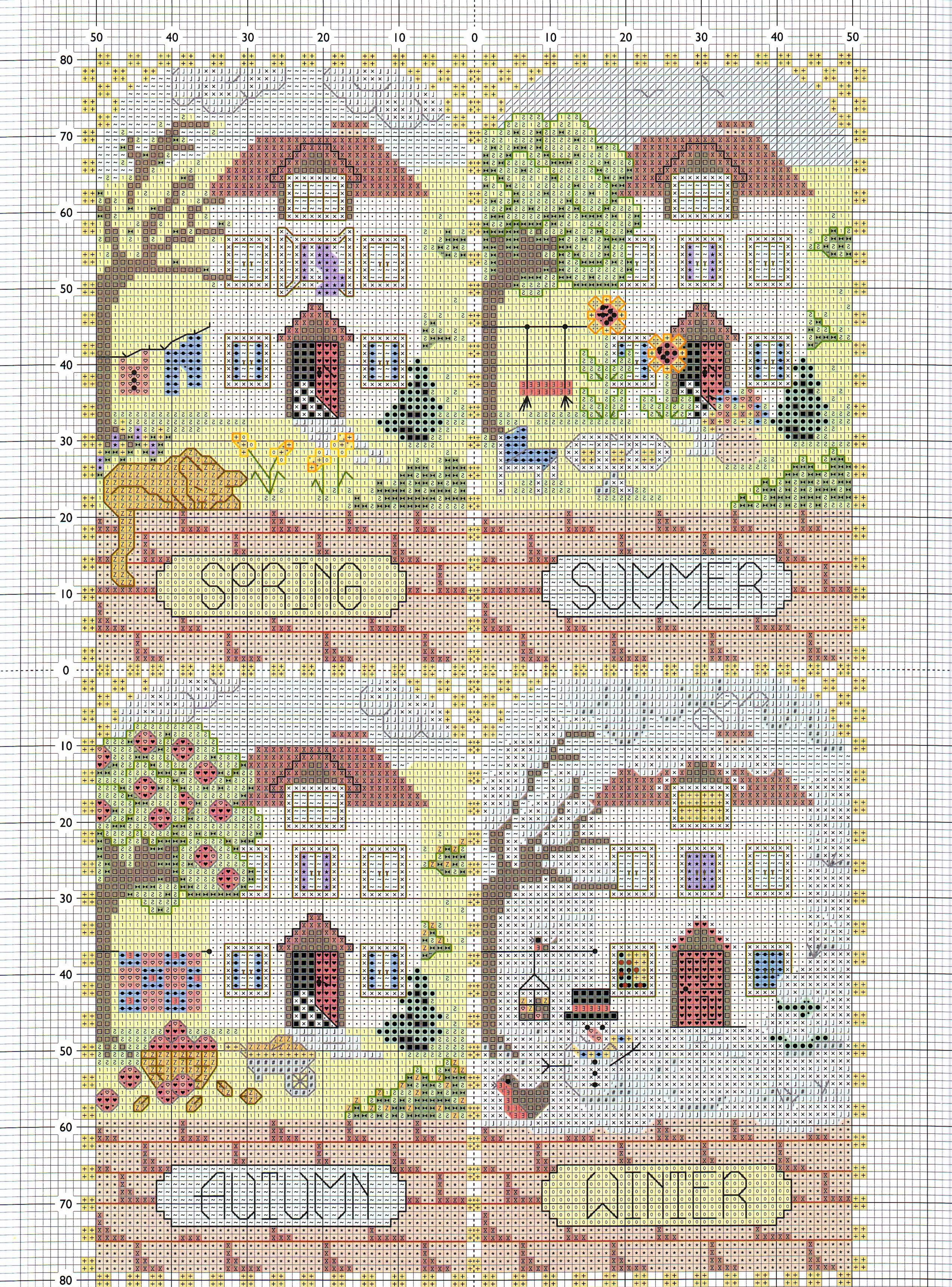

—	339	3830	0312	Dark terracotta wall
—	375	869	2105	Brown window frames, cat, basket, fallen leaves
—	401	535	1713	Dark grey seasonal plaques, washing lines, swing, roofs, porches, doors, snowman hat and arms, bird feeder

French knots in one strand

●	339	3830	0312	Dark terracotta christmas tree lights in window
●	401	535	1713	Dark grey swing, washing lines, and washing, sunflower centres, door handles, snowman, birds

For perfect results, we suggest you stitch the seasonal houses in Anchor threads on 14 count aida

Picture stitch count
162 high x 104 wide

Design area
30x19cm (11 5/8x7 3/8in)

'I stitched the border first which meant I could switch between the different seasons for a bit of variety, or to finish off a thread colour. There wasn't anything too tricky, although I found its size was a bit of a challenge.'

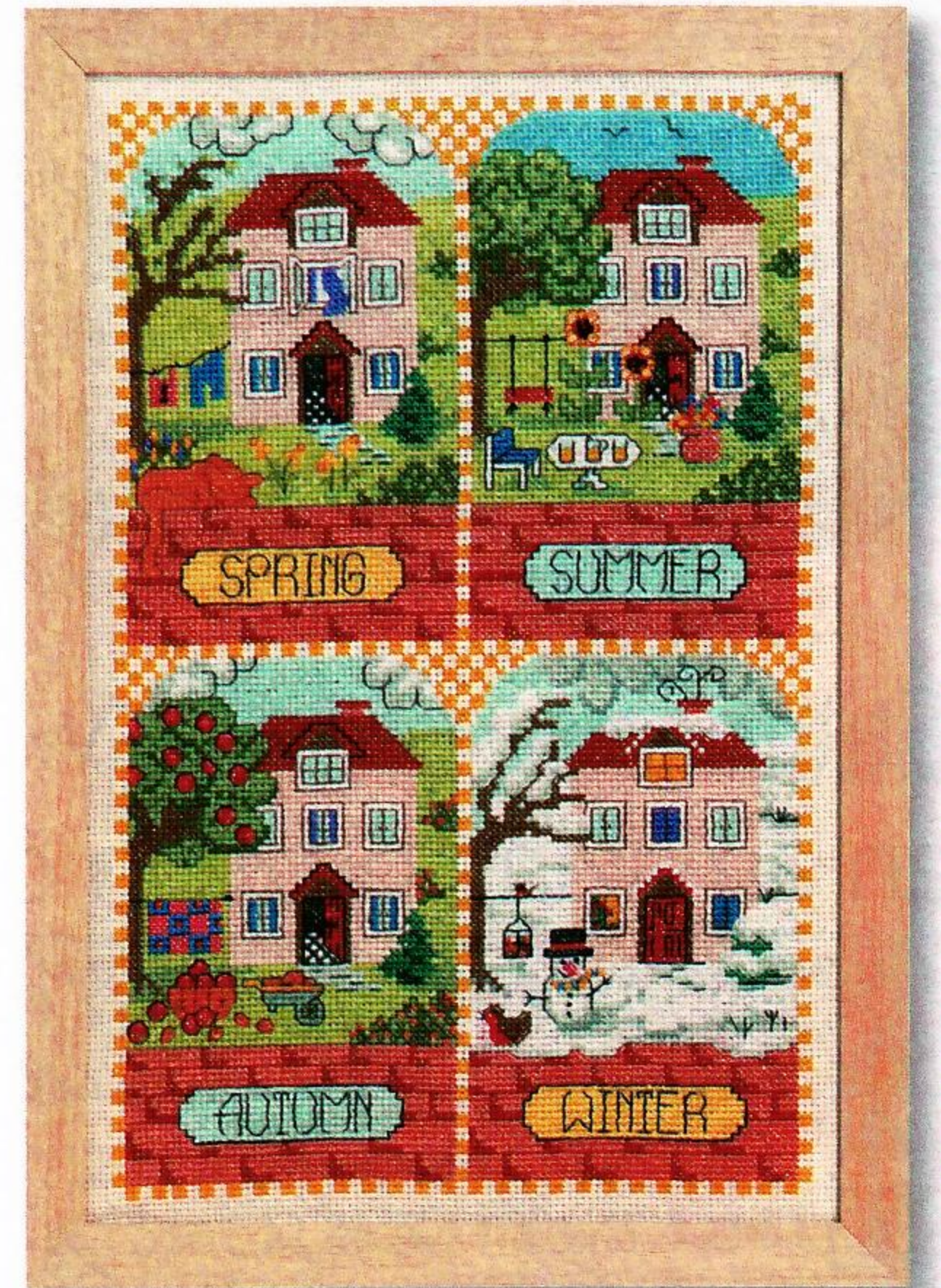

Seasonal homes

- Stranded cotton as listed in the key
- Tapestry needle size 24
- 14 count cream aida 46x34cm (18x13 1/2in)
- Wooden frame with visual aperture of 31.5x20.5cm (12 1/2x8in)
- Wadding to fit frame aperture



Pick your favourite season, and frame it in an aperture card from Craft Creations, ref AP02U. This aperture size will fit the design perfectly, minus the checked yellow and white border. Call Craft Creations on ☎ 01992 781 900 or visit www.craftcreations.com

Instant Expert

In the frame

You'll find a roller frame invaluable when working this design. Because it's a large design with a lot of stitching involved, your fabric can easily pucker or distort, but by keeping your stitching taut in an embroidery frame you will help to prevent this.
