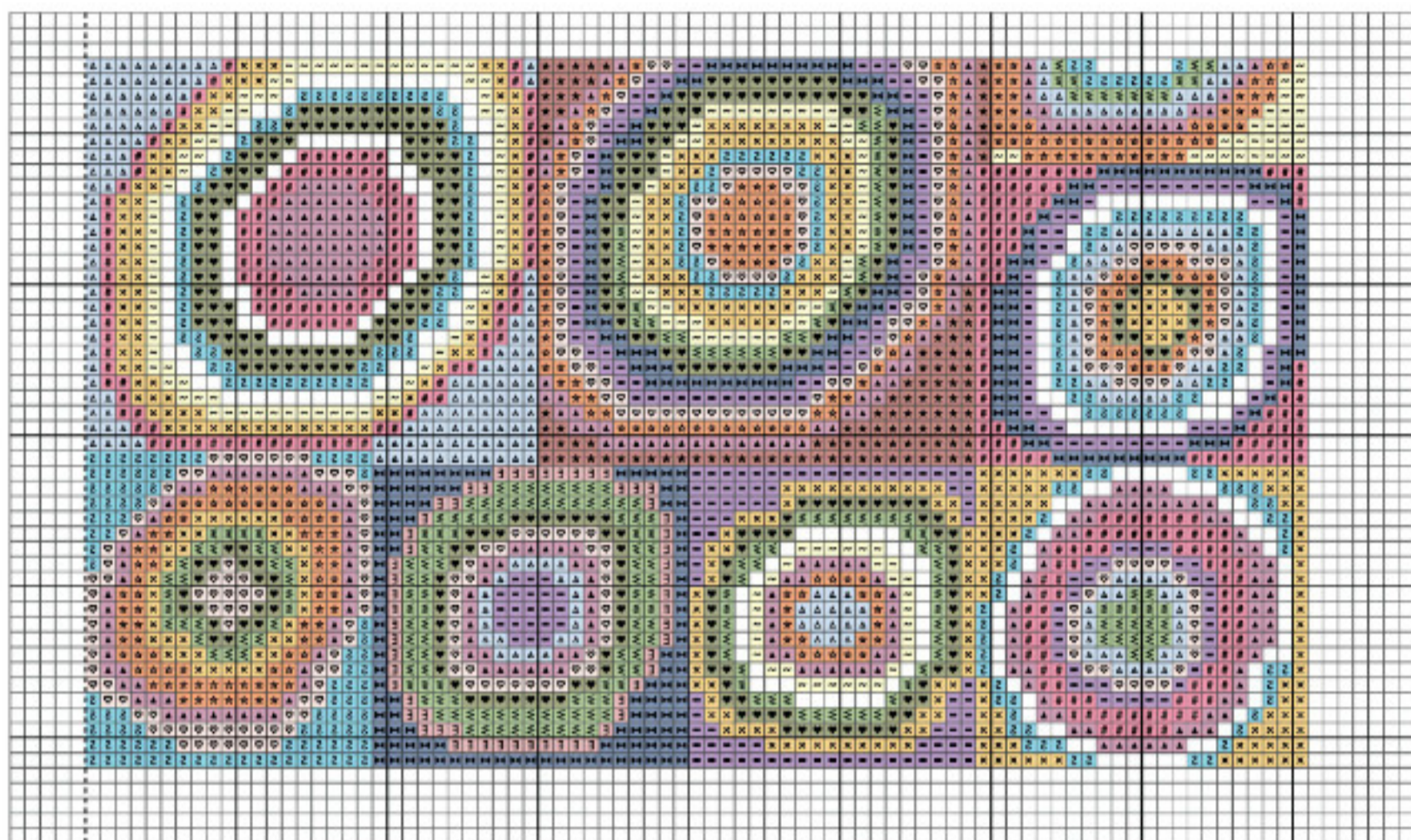

Materials

- 25 count green evenweave, 50x50cm
- Green cotton backing fabric: one piece 36x36cm for the back, and three gusset pieces 36x7cm
- Mustard cotton lining fabric: two pieces 36x36cm for back and front, and three gusset pieces 36x7cm
- Pink cotton strap fabric, two pieces 11x80cm
- Webbing, 4x160cm

Make a... shoulder bag

Step 1

JOIN the three green gusset pieces together at the short ends to make one long strip. Trim your stitched evenweave to the same size as the bag back, then stitch your gusset strip down the side of the evenweave, along the bottom and up the other side.

Step 2

STITCH the bag back to the other side of the gusset. Stitch the lining pieces together in the same way, by joining the gusset pieces, then stitching them to the lining front and back. Leave a gap in one seam so you can turn your bag right sides out later.

Step 3

PLACE the lining inside the bag outer, right sides together and matching seams. Stitch together round the top. Turn the bag right sides out through the gap in the lining and stitch up the hole. Push the lining inside. Topstitch around the upper edge of your bag.

Step 4

MAKE the handle by joining the pink strips at the short ends then stitching right sides together along the length to make a tube. Turn right sides out and feed the webbing through, turning the short ends of the fabric under. Stitch to each side of the bag.
