Kewpies with Bows

Framed Baby Keepsake

You need: 17"x21" white Aida 18; 1 yd. of 5/16"-wide blue, double-face, satin ribbon; 14"x16-3/4" lightweight fleece; 14"x16-3/4" heavyweight cardboard; dental floss; 14"x16-3/4" gold and blue frame.

1. On the Aida fabric, center and stitch the Kewpies with Bows design, using two additional repeats of the ribbon border section indicated on the chart.

2. Center the "Treasured Keepsake" saying within the ribbon border, aligning the vertical centers. The saying begins 11 "threads" below the central ribbons' ends.

This design would also make a charming birth sampler. Substitute name and birthdate for the saying provided.

NOTE: Use DMC 632 for Alphabet letters. If you wish to substitute pink ribbons for blue, substitute DMC 818 for 775; 776 for 3325; 899 for 813; and 335 for 322.
